


## **Current Transducer HAT 750-S**

For the electronic measurement of currents: DC, AC, pulsed,..., with galvanic separation between the primary circuit and the secondary circuit.



Ignoring this warning can lead to injury and/or cause serious damage.


This transducer is a build-in device, whose conducting parts must be inaccessible after installation.

#### **Remarks**

- $\bullet \ \ V_{\mbox{\tiny out}}$  is positive when  $I_{\mbox{\tiny P}}$  flows in the direction of the arrow.
- Temperature of the primary conductor should not exceed 105 °C.
